Junior High Avalanche is a weekend winter retreat for those in **6th-9th grades**.

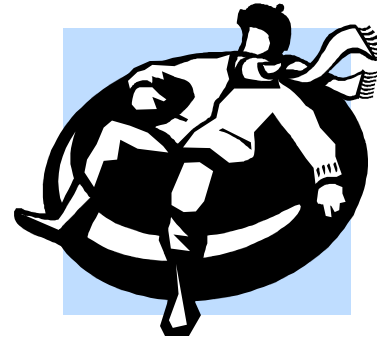
We will be playing all kinds of **games** and having a great time on the **tubing hill**. Our speaker, **Jim Johnson**, will be great as well!
