(We do allow a grade above or below depending on how your youth group is set up.)

Dates: December 31st, (7:30pm) - January 3rd, (11:30am), 2010. Celebrate the New Year at Big Sandy Camp!

Cost: \$70/camper; \$25/leader (Same price as last year)

- Fees are transferable within your group but not refundable, since spaces are reserved. (Just call me with any updates.)

Speaker: **Scott Woller** (Lead Pastor) grew up on a farm just outside of Upsala, MN. Scott worked with his dad on the farm, but also worked at Camp Lebanon, a Christian camp just a few miles away from Upsala, where he found his love and passion for ministry. Following college Scott joined the pastoral staff of Christian Life in Lubbock, Texas, where he was the youth pastor for six years. Scott and Amber established Corner Church in the spring of 2005 and look forward to years of seeing its vision and goals accomplished. Here's how the three Winter Youth Retreats work...

Registration Process:

1. **Coordinator:** Appoint one person from your church as the "Senior High Avalanche Retreat Coordinator". Please write their name on the poster as the person to contact. This person would be responsible for the following details, making sure everybody gets the needed information.
 - a. **Money:** Students turn money in to the coordinator for the retreat, *before* the call-in date (Dec. 10th), checks made out to the local church.
 - b. **Registration/Medical Forms:** The coordinator collects completed registration/medical forms for all students and adults. (A form is included in this packet for you to photocopy, and also available online.)

- c. **Call In Day: Thursday, Dec. 10th (9AM to 5PM)** the coordinator reserves the number of spaces needed by calling camp. This is the first day to reserve space for your group. At the time of the call, the camp can verify the amount for which the church should draft a check. Checks and reg./med. forms may be brought to camp at the time of the retreat. When you call, please have both numbers and names of everyone attending (including leader)
- d. **Bring to camp**
 - 1) The collected medical/registration forms (form included)
 - 2) The list of names (form included)
 - 3) And one check from the church made out to Big Sandy Camp to cover costs for the whole group.

Check-in at camp is Thursday, 7:30 PM in Lakeview Lodge Dining Hall. Have the list of people from your church complete, with any changes noted.

COUNSELORS:

- It is suggested that each church sending more than 4 students would try to send at least one counselor.
- Anyone wishing to counsel should apply through Big Sandy Camp prior to call-in day (please find a master application form included or get the form online).
- Because space is limited, it is important to communicate to all concerned that **housing is provided only to those counselors who receive written confirmation** of their acceptance and to adults specifically involved in the program. **(Drivers should not plan to stay.)**
- Many churches are able to reimburse the counselor's fee of \$25.
- Please have counselors from your church submit applications before the call-in date of Dec. 10th.

BRING:

- sleeping bag or bedding (single), pillow
- towel, toiletries, toothpaste, etc.
- Bible, pen or pencil
- outdoor clothes for winter fun
- a little spending money
(snack shop and General Store will be open)

PLEASE DO NOT BRING:

- electronic devices like...
 - * cell phones, ipods, radios, stereos
- small or expensive personal items
- alcohol, tobacco, non-prescription drugs
- matches, lighter, knives, weapons
- magazines

Thank you once again for all your help and with the promotion of Senior High Avalanche and the other winter retreats. You are truly a blessing to the Big Sandy Camp ministry. To ensure you get all the spots you need for your group, I encourage you to call in early on the call-in day.
